Minutes of an emergency meeting of Colney Heath Parish Council held at the Community Room Colney Heath Village Hall, High Street Colney Heath on Monday 29 April at 7.45pm

1. Colney Heath Queens's Jubilee Fete Committee

1.2 Loan Cllr Clarke on behalf of the Jubilee Committee made a brief presentation regarding the Celebration. Various Village Bodies (WI, Scouts Church etc) have banded together to provide three days of festivities culminating in a firework display provided by a professional firework company at the Football Ground, at the High Street Recreation Area on June 3. The Committee has appointed a Treasurer who will be opening a dedicated bank account. The Committee have arranged that there will be various fund raising activities over the weekend but £500 is needed in 'seed money' to place a deposit against the firework display. Cllr Clarke asked if the Parish Council would be prepared to loan the Committee this money immediately. After discussion it was unanimously agreed to loan the Jubilee Committee the £500 and the Clerk was directed to offer it to them with the proviso that the money should be paid back by the end of June.

1.2 Grant – Cllr Clarke also asked if the Council would consider a grant of £500 to be used as the Committee saw fit but probably towards the firework display. Councillors felt the Budget had been allocated, but money could be taken from the contingency fund and replaced next year. It was therefore unanimously agreed to give the Jubilee Committee a grant of £500.

Highfield Trust – Cllr Ellis reported the Highfield Trust is combining with St Luke's Church to provide a Jubilee Celebration

There being no further business the meeting was closed at 8pm.
