

# Road Closures and Lane Closures

## Installation of Traffic Signals and Resurfacing Works A414 North Orbital Road

Dear Resident,

We are writing to tell you about some works we'll be undertaking in your area.

We understand these works may be an inconvenience to you, however, we ask you to support us as we make the necessary improvements.

The junction of the A414 North Orbital Road and High Street, Colney Heath is to have traffic signals installed. In addition, the longabout at the junction and its Eastbound approach is to be resurfaced. Work is programmed to commence on the 17<sup>th</sup> of August 2020 for 11 weeks.

To create a safe working environment for the workforce and members of the public alike, the works will be carried out with the following traffic management.

### **Traffic signals installation**

#### **17<sup>th</sup> August to 2<sup>nd</sup> October**

Nearside lane closure of the A414 Eastbound and Westbound side of the longabout. During the Westbound lane closure High Street, Colney Heath will also be closed at its junction with the A414 North Orbital Road.

#### **2<sup>nd</sup> October to 22<sup>nd</sup> October**

Offside lane closure of the A414 Eastbound and Westbound side of the longabout.

### **Surfacing Works**

#### **12<sup>th</sup> October to 23<sup>rd</sup> October**

Night closure of the A414 North Orbital Road Eastbound then Westbound between London Colney and the junction with the A1M.

A temporary 30mph speed limit will be in place on the A414 North Orbital Road when traffic management is in place.

The working hours are described in the table below;

Some degree of disruption and delay can be expected as a result of these works and whilst we will make every effort to minimise these please allow extra time for any journeys you may make while these works are in progress. We greatly appreciate your patience and co-operation.

### What you need to know:

- We would like to reassure residents that we are following Government advice relating to construction works and guidelines regarding social distancing to minimise the risks related to Covid-19 (Coronavirus).
- We politely request that all residents respect our workforce and follow social distancing guidelines when passing the works area or engaging with our on-site team.
- **Vehicles may not be allowed access through the road closure during the works, except for emergency vehicles. We are unable to provide information on which part of the road will have access and when. Please speak to the on-site team on the day who will be able to advise on this.**
- Please refer to the yellow signboards at either end of your street to see the exact dates, timings and permit number. Any date changes to these works will be communicated on these yellow signboards and at [www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/roadclosures](http://www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/roadclosures)
- These works are weather dependent and may be postponed if poor weather is forecast.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works and all local businesses will be open as usual.
