SUBJECT:	SUBMISSIONS FOR ROAD NAMES

1. BACKGROUND

As you may know, the Street Naming and Numbering department in St Albans District Council uses suggested names provided by Parish Councils to allocate to new buildings and roads within each parish.

The current list has been mostly used up now and the District Council are offering the opportunity to put names forward that can be used for such purposes to celebrate the residents/history of the parish.

2. PARAMETERS FOR STREET NAMING

For new streets we ask for a name that has a historical or local link to the area and is easily spelled and pronounced.

When providing new names please be sure to avoid names that:

- Already exist (Names that have already been used in naming a house or a road)
- Are too long or otherwise complicated (This is to avoid issues when it comes to deliveries of goods and more importantly when the Emergency services are trying to locate the property)
- Are not considered appropriate (Names that could be perceived as rude or obscene)
- Refer to inflammatory historical events or figures (e.g. Names that refer to slave owners, criminals or otherwise potentially offensive events or historical figures)

Please provide any suggested names along with a brief description of the historical or local link.

Deadline for street names is Thursday 6th May 2021.

3. SUGGESTIONS

Councillors are asked to make suggestions and agree to submit these for each Wards within the Parish should a new road or street requiring naming.

The following have been suggested by the Clerk and are suggested to get Councillors thinking about suggested names to put forward along with the reasoning behind the suggestions. The list is not exhaustive and can be amended or added to.

For Colney Heath Ward:

Crump Crescent

Named after the service of a Parish Councillor for over 20 years.

Walsh Way

Named after a volunteer who has assisted in managing and looking after the Colney Heath Village Hall for over 20 years.

Nash Street

Named after the Common Ranger who has cared for and still does work for the Parish Council watching over the Common and all who use it.

Marlborough Street

Another long serving volunteer and Chairman of the Colney Heath Football Club.

Warren Close

Named after an important area of Colney Heath Common

Brazier Road

Named after the District Councillor who has given over 20 years of service to the village and community.

Reeves Place

Named after a volunteer associated with the Charles Morris Hall who also served as a Parish Councillor.

For Hill End Ward:

Prince Phillip Way

Following the royal theme as we have Princess Diana Drive this is a fitting suggestion given the timing of the request

Earthworks View

This is in Hill End and would recognise the work carried out here for many years

For Highfield Ward:

Alexandra Avenue

Named after one of the wards in Hill End Hospital

Hine Road

Named after the designer and architect of Hill End Hospital

Barnes Drive

Named after a Councillor who has served for over 10 years in the Ward

Solts Close

Named after a Councillor who has served for over 10 years in the Ward
